On 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2014, the 2<sup>nd</sup> year Leading Program students of Nagasaki University conducted a seminar for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year medical school students of the same university. Themed “Time to think about your career”, the seminar was a follow-up to an earlier seminar held in the preceding semester for the 4<sup>th</sup> year medical school students by the first generation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year Leading Program students. The activities carried out during the seminar were the same for both days and consisting of self-introduction, group discussion and career path presentation by students with medical background. The leading program students were also introduced to the basics of research, which paved way for an elaborate overview of the Leading Program. During discussion sessions, the medical students were able to impressively communicate in English with foreign students and were stimulated to begin to think about their future career, as evidenced by the feedback from group discussions and pre and postseminar questionnaires. Besides benefiting the medical students, the preparation and execution of the seminar activities also acted to sharpen the Leading Program students’ skills in public presentation/communication, event organization and time management.
